## The Government Offices include

The Government governs the nation. It is an integral authority comprising the Prime Minister and the Government Offices including ministries.

### Prime Minister's Office

The Prime Minister's Office directs and coordinates the work of the Government Offices. It is furthermore responsible for coordination of Sweden's EU policy, coordinates sustainable development work in the Government Offices and is responsible for constitutional policy and election issues.

### Ministry of Agriculture

The Ministry of Agriculture has a wide range of responsibilities, including matters relating to agriculture, forestry, fisheries, reindeer husbandry, Sami affairs, animal welfare, food and hunting and game management.

### Ministry of Culture

The Ministry of Culture is responsible for culture, the media and sports.

### Ministry of Defence

The Ministry of Defence aims to fulfil the objectives set by the Government and Riksdagen.
